#### Substance Abuse Treatment National Outcomes Measures (NOMS) Corrective Action Plan (CAP) Information

The Wyoming Department of Health, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services Division (the Division) and comprehensive substance abuse center (SAC) providers funded by federal and state dollars must act in response to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA)-imposed Corrective Action Plan (CAP). SAMHSA has imposed a CAP because FY09 client level outcome data does not demonstrate the effectiveness of treatment services pursuant to the NOMS domains.

The first phase of the CAP is the examination of SAC data via an environmental scan. The purpose of this scan is to begin an interactive process between the Division and local agencies regarding substance abuse client outcome data change as compared at admission and at discharge; and how the change does or does not align with the federal data expectations. The anticipated outcome of this first phase is increased awareness of SAC and statewide data patterns leading improvement in client outcomes as a result of treatment services. Success of this project is dependent upon a strong partnership between treatment providers and the Division.

The Division has produced an Environmental Scan Data Report for each provider agency, which will be located on the WCIS website under "Documents" in the WCIS Alerts and Communications area (available to view on [April 1, 2010](#)). All SACs with at least one active SA Agency Code are required to review this report; complete the provider CAP template for submission by May 1, 2010; and participate in the kick-off conference call to discuss the report. Any agency who wishes to discuss their report/data at greater length is invited to schedule a follow-up call with the Division.
