What are Communicable Disease Prevention Programs Funding Opportunities?

Mission: increase the awareness of and decrease the incidence of HIV, viral hepatitis and other STDs in Wyo-

The Communicable Disease Unit will be offering two types of funding:

- for the purchase of communicable disease prevention supplies such as educational materials, condoms, etc.
- for local entities to carry out specials projects in their community of service consistent with the specified mission.

Examples of Special Projects

- Special outreach events
- Patient or provider education
- Community workshops
- View the Communicable Disease Unit Master Calendar for specified Awareness Days/Months.

Examples include:

- World AIDS day events
- STD Awareness Month Events
- Viral Hepatitis Awareness Month Events

Priority populations

All funded efforts must target one or more high risk population identified by the Wyoming Department of Health Communicable Disease Unit listed below:

- Men who have sex with men (MSM)
- Adolescents (13-17 years)
- Young Adults (18-24 Years)
- HIV Positives
- Viral Hepatitis Positives
- Injection Drug Users (IDUs)

Funding Guidelines

- Funding may not exceed \$1,500 per project.
- Agencies may apply for more than one project per year.
- Application period: February 1, 2013 December 1, 2013
- Application deadline: December 1, 2013
- To receive funding for prevention materials, entities will be awarded funds prior to purchasing supplies.
- To receive funding for special projects, entities will be awarded funds post project evaluation; all invoices for special projects must be billed to the Wyoming Department of Health no later than December 31, 2013.

Funding Restrictions

- Grants can be used for resources and activities that enhance HIV/STD awareness and testing
- Collaboration is welcome; however, a public or private non-profit agency must be identified as the lead agency for the project
- No funding will be awarded for salaries, stipends, or scholarships
- Only complete applications will be considered
