

## PUBLIC NOTICE

### Intent to Adopt Rules Wyoming Department of Health

Public notice is hereby given that the Wyoming Department of Health intends to repeal rules Chs. 1-4 Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Directives pursuant to W.S. §§ 35-22-201 to -208, 2015 Wyoming Session Laws Ch. 189, and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act at W.S. §§ 16-3-101 to -115. The agencies also intends to adopt Rules pursuant to the provisions of Wyoming Statute §§ 35-1-801 through -805, the Wyoming Emergency Medical Services Act of 1977 at Wyoming Statute §§ 33-36-101 through -115, and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act at Wyoming Statute §§ 16-3-101 through -115. All of the rules meet minimum substantive state statutory requirements.

#### Chapters 1 through 4, Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Directives

The Department is repealing these rules in compliance with House Enrolled Act No. 95 (HEA95) of the Sixty-Third Wyoming Legislature. This Act repealed Wyo. Stat. Ann. §§ 35-22-201 through 35-22-208 effective July 1, 2016.

The repeal of these rules, and the concurrent adoption of the rules for Provider Orders for Life Sustaining Treatment Program Act, will provide a seamless transition for the programs.

#### Chapter 14, Community EMS Practitioners, Agencies, and Education Programs

The Department in promulgating these Rules will establish and implement the procedures for the education and endorsement of Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) as Community EMS Technicians or Clinicians, and for the establishment of Community EMS Programs as part of the comprehensive emergency medical services (EMS) and trauma system.

The Wyoming Department of Health welcomes all comments and suggestions on these rules. Any person may urge the Agency not to adopt this Rule and may request that the Agency state its reasons for overruling the consideration urged against adoption. Written comments must be submitted to the above address no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 28, 2016.

Interested parties may request a statement of the Department's position regarding each comment and the action taken as a result of the comments prior to, or within thirty (30) days after, adoption of these Rules. Requests must be submitted to the above address. If requested, the statement will be issued by the Department within thirty (30) days after the Agency action.
