

PUBLIC NOTICE

Intent to Adopt Rules Wyoming Department of Health

Public notice is hereby given that the Wyoming Department of Health intends to adopt the following amended Rules pursuant to the provisions of Wyoming Statute §§ 35-1-801 through -805, the Wyoming Emergency Medical Services Act of 1977 at Wyoming Statute §§ 33-36-101 through -115, and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act at Wyoming Statute §§ 16-3-101 through -115. These rules meet minimum substantive state statutory requirements.

Chapter 4, Response and Reporting Requirements

The Department in promulgating these Rules will clarify the circumstances under which an emergency medical services (EMS) patient care report may be released. Additionally, the Department will clarify that it is the responsibility of EMS personnel to ensure accurate and timely submission of reports. Other proposed changes bring consistency to formatting and comport with the Secretary of State's Rules on Rules.

A public hearing will be held if requested by 25 persons, by a governmental subdivision, or by an association having not less than 25 members.

The Wyoming Department of Health welcomes all comments and suggestions on these rules. Any person may urge the Agency not to adopt this Rule and may request that the Agency state its reasons for overruling the consideration urged against adoption. Written comments must be submitted to the above address no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 28, 2016.

Interested parties may request a statement of the Department's position regarding each comment and the action taken as a result of the comments prior to, or within thirty (30) days after, adoption of these Rules. Requests must be submitted to the above address. If requested, the statement will be issued by the Department within thirty (30) days after the Agency action.
