This year the WDH received the fewest reports of human West Nile virus infection since the introduction of the disease in 2002. In regards to the human cases reported this year, 67% were female, 33% were male. The age range of patients reported was from 16 to 53 years old with a median age of 38 years. Reported symptom onset dates ranged from 7/16/2010 through 9/21/2010.
