Wyoming Department of Health, Medicaid
Changes to the Data Exchange with State Motor Vehicles to State Plan

March 2, 2016

Public and Tribal notice is hereby given that effective January 1, 2017 the Wyoming Department of Health, Division of Healthcare Financing (Medicaid) will change how it conducts a data match with the Wyoming Department of Transportation to identify Wyoming Medicaid clients involved in motor vehicle accidents

The agency, or their designee, accesses the Wyoming Department of Transportation, Highway Safety Program's crash database on a monthly basis and matches data to the Medicaid claims processing system.

The agency executed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the Department of Transportation, Highway Safety program. Pursuant to this MOU, the agency, or their designee, is authorized to access the state of Wyoming motor vehicle crash data. By using identifying demographic information, the MMIS Fiscal Agent will match individuals involved in car accidents with Wyoming Medicaid clients. Any positive matches will result in the notifying liable third parties of Medicaid's reimbursement right, requesting reimbursement, and tracking all actions in a TPL tracking database.

The proposed change will update language requiring the use of external cause codes to the Requirements for Third Party Liability – Identifying Liable Resources in Section 4.22 of Attachment 4.22A of the Wyoming Medicaid State Plan.
