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Wyoming Medicaid Births 2009

This report is based on claims paid through the Medicaid MMIS system through June 2010 for births occurring in calendar year 2009. Provisional data for Wyoming statewide births was supplied by the Preventative Health and Safety Division and Vital Records Services.

In summary there were:

- 7,841 births to Wyoming residents in 2009 which is an decrease of 174 from 2008
- 3,401 Medicaid births in 2009, which is a increase of 48 births from 2008
- 206 of the Medicaid births were financed at least partially by third party insurance in 2009
- 217 of the Medicaid births occurred out of state in 2009
- 220 of the Medicaid births occurred to women in coverage groups other than Pregnant Women programs

This report includes a table to display the number of births by county to non citizens. These births are covered under the Emergency Services regulation that requires Medicaid to cover labor and delivery charges for non citizens.
