

PUBLIC NOTICE

Intent to Adopt New and Amended Rules Wyoming Department of Health

Public notice is hereby given that the Wyoming Department of Health intends to file Amended and Repealed Rules pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 33-36-101 et. seq., and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act at Wyo. Stat. §§ 16-3-101 through 115. These Rules meet minimum substantive state statutory requirements.

Chapter 5- Personnel Licensure Requirements

The Department is promulgating the Chapter 5, Section 15 to establish and implement the procedures for the issuance of conditional licenses for Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT). The 63rd Legislature of the State of Wyoming passed Senate Enrolled Act no. 65 which required the Department of Health to adopt rules and regulations for the issuance of conditional license to applicants for EMT licensure while awaiting the return of results from criminal background checks. The addition of Chapter 5, Section 15 will establish those procedures.

Chapter 11- Medical Director Stipends

Chapter 11-Medical Director Stipends is being repealed. Chapter 11 was adopted to address an appropriation authorized by the 59th Legislature that provided a monthly stipend to Physician Medical Directors. The appropriation is no longer available; therefore the chapter is being repealed.


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A public hearing will be held if requested by 25 persons, by a governmental subdivision, or by an association having not less than 25 members.

The Wyoming Department of Health welcomes all comments and suggestions on these Rules. Any person may urge the Agency not to adopt these Rules and may request that the Agency state its reasons for overruling the consideration urged against adoption. Written comments must be submitted to the above address no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 14, 2015.

Interested parties may request a statement of the Department's position regarding each comment and the action taken as a result of the comments prior to, or within thirty (30) days after, adoption of these Rules. Requests must be submitted to the above address. If requested, the statement will be issued by the Department within thirty (30) days after the Agency action.
