Rules and Regulations for Wyoming Emergency Medical Services
Intent to Adopt New Rules

Statement of Reasons

The Wyoming Department of Health proposes to adopt the following New Rules pursuant to the provisions of W.S. § 33-36-101 *et seq.*, and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act at W.S. § 16-3-101, *et seq.*

The Department in promulgating these Rules will establish and implement the procedures for the issuance of conditional licenses for Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT), and repeal unneeded rules.

The 63rd Legislature of the state of Wyoming passed Senate Enrolled Act No. 65 which requires the Department of Health to adopt rules and regulations for the issuance of conditional licenses to applicants for EMT licensure while awaiting the return of results from a criminal background check. The addition of Section 15 to Chapter 5 of the *Rules and Regulations for Wyoming Emergency Medical Services* will establish those procedures.

Chapter 11 was adopted to address an appropriation authorized by the 59th Legislature that provided a monthly stipend to Physician Medical Directors. The appropriation is no longer available, therefore Chapter 11 is being repealed.

W.S. § 33-36-103(a) requires the Department to confer with private and volunteer ambulance services prior to promulgating rules. A webinar was conducted on June 4, 2015, to fulfill this requirement.

As required by W.S. § 16-3-103(a)(i)(G), these rules and regulations meet minimum substantive state statutory requirements.
