- ❖ Employment Discovery and Customization
- ❖ Prevocational Services
- ❖ Individual and Group Supported Employment

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Adult Day Services

- ❖ Structured services consisting of meaningful day activities that maximize or maintain skills and abilities. Services are usually provided in a congregate setting.
- ❖ Available to individuals who are 21 years of age or older who:
 - ❖ Have chosen not to be employed;
 - ❖ Are unable to be employed; or
 - ❖ Are unable to participate in community integrated services due to physical disabilities or stamina.

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Adult Day Services

- ❖ Participants may not be paid for work activities during this service.
- ❖ Staff must be on-site within immediate proximity.
- ❖ Transportation is included in the rate.
- ❖ May receive Community Integration, Supported Employment, and Prevocational services concurrently on the plan with this service.

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Behavioral Support Services

- ❖ Service includes training, supervision, or assistance in acquisition of appropriate behaviors and reduction of inappropriate behaviors through the implementation of positive behavior support and interventions.
- ❖ This service can also be accessed for the intent purpose of reducing the use of restrictions and restraints within a participant's current plan of care or service environment.

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Behavioral Support Services

- ❖ Provider is required to be a certified waiver provider.
- ❖ The individual who provides the service must also have a Master's Degree and be a Board Certified Behavior Analyst or have similar nationally recognized certification in positive behavior supports with approval from the Division.

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Community Integration Services

(Formerly Day Habilitation)

- ❖ Offers assistance with acquisition, retention, or improvement in self-help, socialization, and adaptive skills that maximize or maintain skills and abilities.
- ❖ Must be delivered differently from Adult Day Care services.
- ❖ At least half of the weekly time of service is devoted to helping the participant plan, access, participate, and interact with community and community members.
- ❖ Participants may not be paid for work activities performed.

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Community Integration Services

(Formerly Day Habilitation)

- ❖ Providers must have 1 staff person who works at least 50% of their time as a service supervisor be certified in a nationally recognized supported employment curriculum.
- ❖ This staff must also demonstrate that a portion of their time each month is spent training direct care staff in the following categories:
 - Exploring employment interests
 - Working on job readiness skills
 - Other employment related activities that will benefit participants

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Crisis Intervention Services

- ❖ This service may be added for situations where a participant's tier level may not provide sufficient support for specific instances, but the extensive supervision is **not** needed at all times.
- ❖ Service is available for participants ages 18 + in residential or day services.
- ❖ Quantity of caps approved by the Division's Clinical Review Team and shall be based on verified evidence of the diagnosis or condition requiring this service.

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Crisis Intervention Services

- ❖ A CARF provider serving 5+ participants with restraints or restrictive interventions in their plans are required to have a supervisor successfully complete the Positive Behavior Support curriculum developed by WIND or a nationally recognized positive behavior support curriculum approved by the Division.
- ❖ An additional supervisor must be certified for every 10 additional participants with restraints or restrictive interventions in their plan.

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Employment PATHWAY

Employment Pathway services include:

- ❖ Prevocational Services
- ❖ Employment Discovery and Customization
- ❖ Small Group Supported Employment
- ❖ Individual Supported Employment
- ❖ Supported Employment Follow Along
- ❖ Transportation

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Prevocational Services

- ❖ Designed to create a path to integrated community-based employment where compensation is comparable to their peers without disabilities.
- ❖ Services may be furnished in a variety of locations in the community and are not limited to provider facilities.
- ❖ May be provided at a volunteer worksite or mentorship locations for the purpose of helping someone obtain competitive employment.

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Prevocational Services

- ❖ Participation in prevocational services is not a required pre-requisite for individual or small group supported employment services provided under the waiver.
- ❖ Prevocational services are time-limited and should not exceed 12 consecutive months. In some cases, an additional 12 months may be approved by the Division in subsequent years with submission of an approved employment plan.
- ❖ Participants receive a tiered service approved in the plan of care using three tiers.

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Employment Discovery & Customization

- ❖ Service should help develop employment through job carving, discovering one's interests and strengths, exploring self-employment, or entrepreneurial initiatives.
- ❖ 1:1 support service and with a limited time frame of 12 months.
- ❖ Initially, 100 units will be approved for a strengths, needs and interests assessment
- ❖ Then, 300 additional units may be approved to complete an employment plan and conduct mentorships or volunteer activities to explore jobs and fields of interest.

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Employment Discovery & Customization

- ❖ Employment Discovery and Customization must have one staff working at least 50% of their time as a job coach/developer must be certified in a nationally recognized supported employment curriculum if serving up to 10 participants and an additional staff certified for every 10 participants thereafter.
- ❖ An additional 12 months may be approved by the Division upon review of the progress made the prior year.
- ❖ Services are for ages 18+ and **cannot** be provided during school hours for participants between ages 18 and 21.

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Supported Employment Follow Along (SEFA)

- ❖ Service is provided for or on behalf of a participant through intermittent and occasional job support, communicating with the participant's supervisor or manager, whether in the presence of the participant or not.
- ❖ 15 minute rate for up to 100 units annually.
- ❖ Approved units are based upon individual need in order to maintain employment.

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Transportation

- ❖ Gap service to enable participants to gain access to an employment location, community services, activities, and resources as specified by the plan of care when a service provider is not needed at the event.
- ❖ Transportation shall be offered in accordance with an individual's Plan of Care and whenever possible family, neighbors, friends or community agencies should be utilized.
- ❖ Cannot replace formal or informal options such as natural supports, city transportation, or travel voucher.

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Transportation

- ❖ Cannot be used for medical appointments required under 42 CFR 431.53 or under the Medicaid state plan.
- ❖ Reimbursed based on mileage and capped at \$2,000 per year.
- ❖ Must be a certified waiver provider including certified for this service.
- ❖ Cannot be used in conjunction with or to access other waiver services that have transportation included in the service rate.

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Child Habilitation Services

- ❖ Service Definition remains the same.
- ❖ Comprehensive Waiver has annual cap of 9400 units.
- ❖ Supports Waiver does not have unit cap.
- ❖ Must be based on assessed need and fit within assigned budget amount.

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Companion Services

- ❖ Service Definition remains the same.
- ❖ Service may be provided up to 9 hours a day.
- ❖ Comprehensive Waiver has an annual cap of 1664 units.
- ❖ May provide service to 2 or 3 participants at the same time but must use the group rate in order to bill.
- ❖ Companion Services does not have a unit cap on the Supports Waiver.
- ❖ Companion services cannot be provided in conjunction with other habilitation services, and if provided on the same day the service must not overlap.

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Dietician

- ❖ Must be a registered Dietician to be certified.
- ❖ Limited to services not provided under the Medicaid State Plan:
 - *State plan must be billed for services prior to the waiver paying for them each year*
- ❖ Sessions must be a minimum of 30 minutes in order to bill.
- ❖ *Participant Specific Training is required.*

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Environmental Modifications

- ❖ Service Definition remains the same.
- ❖ Lifetime cap of \$20,000 per family, regardless of waiver .
- ❖ Lifetime Cap was put in place for purchases beginning July 1, 2013.
- ❖ Critical Health and Safety service requests that exceed the lifetime cap is subject to available funding and approval by Extraordinary Care Committee.

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Homemaker

- ❖ Service Definition remains the same.
- ❖ Supports Waiver does not have a unit cap.
- ❖ Comprehensive Waiver has cap of a maximum of 3 hours per week per household or 624 units per year.
- ❖ **Can now be self-directed on the new waivers.**

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Independent Support Broker

- ❖ Optional service for a participant or legally authorized representative self-directing services.
- ❖ Comprehensive and Supports Waivers have annual cap of 320 units.
- ❖ Individual Budget Amounts will not be increased to add this service.
- ❖ Service shall be provided by a conflict-free support broker.

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Individual Habilitation Training

- ❖ Formerly known as *Residential Habilitation Training*.
- ❖ Specialized **1:1 intensive** training service to assist a participant with the acquisition or improvement in skills for more independence and a higher level of functioning.
- ❖ Supports and training objectives are required.
- ❖ Services may be provided in the person's home or in integrated settings with persons who do not have disabilities.

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Individual Habilitation Training

- ❖ Services have a four (4) hour a day limit.
- ❖ Units shall be approved based upon the participant's need and budget limit.
- ❖ Within a year of being certified in this service and annually thereafter, the provider must successfully complete at least eight (8) hours of continued education.

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Occupational Therapy & Physical Therapy

- ❖ Individual rates are 15 minute units.
- ❖ Group session unit requires a minimum of 30 minute session to bill for one unit.
 - ☐ *(Same code use for either OT group or PT group)*
- ❖ Participant Specific training is now required.
- ❖ State plan must be billed for services prior to the waiver paying for them each year.

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Personal Care

- ❖ Available to all ages as a 1:1 service.
- ❖ No cap on Supports Waiver.
- ❖ Maximum annual cap of 6000 units for non-residential settings.
- ❖ Maximum annual cap of 7280 units for person in residential settings.
- ❖ Used for a participant who needs ongoing supervision but cannot attend a day service due to a medical or health condition that prohibits or limits attendance at a congregate day program.
- ❖ Must be verified and approved by the Division.

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Personal Care

- ❖ Personal care services are included in the habilitation services and cannot be provided in conjunction with habilitation services.
- ❖ If provided on the same day as habilitation services, the service times must not overlap.

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Residential Habilitation

- ❖ Services are reimbursed using a daily unit based upon the level of service need of the participant, where the participant needs some level of ongoing 24 hour support by a provider on site.
- ❖ Services must be furnished in living arrangements subject to §1616(e) of the Social Security Act (the Keys Amendment), and the standards for such services must meet Chapter 45 of the Wyoming Medicaid Rules for facility standards.

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Residential Habilitation

- ❖ Tier levels for this service align with the assessed Level of Service Need for the participant and the expectations of the service as specified in the definition.
- ❖ All supervision and supports delivered must align with the participant's plan of care.
- ❖ The provider must be in the residence of the participant providing service during both awake and sleeping time for a minimum of 8 hours in a 24 hour period (from 12:00am-11:59pm) for the provider to be reimbursed.

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Residential Habilitation - Shared Living

- ❖ This service may be self-directed for an individual in a shared living setting.
- ❖ Shared living setting is where the participant(s) own or lease the residence from an entity that is not a certified waiver provider.
- ❖ May serve up to 3 participants in a shared living situation, but cannot provide any other residential habilitation service.

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Respite

- ❖ Can be reimbursed as a 15 minute unit or a daily rate, 9 hour rule still applies.
- ❖ Supports waiver does not have an annual unit cap.
- ❖ Comprehensive Waiver has a cap for the 15 minute unit of 1664 units annually.
- ❖ The combined use of daily and 15-minute service cannot exceed an average of 8 hours a week of service over the plan year, which is equivalent to 416 hours a year.

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Self-Directed Goods and Services

- ❖ Service Definition remains the same as previous waivers.
- ❖ Electronic technology devices are only allowed once every five (5) years.
- ❖ Like items cannot be purchased during those five (5) years.
- ❖ The Division shall limit the purchase of any general item and only allow the purchase of an iPad or other electronic device if recommended by Certified Specialized Equipment (CSE) professional.

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Skilled Nursing

- ❖ Skilled Nursing services are medical care services delivered to individuals with complex chronic and/or acute medical conditions.
- ❖ The person's care requires a level of expertise that is undeliverable by non-medical trained individuals.
- ❖ Services may not be used if trained provider staff are able to provide the service, such as medication assistance or support for a medical appointment, unless the participant has a **chronic or acute medical condition that requires a skilled nurse's direct support.**
- ❖ Must maintain current First Aid certification and Participant Specific Training.

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Special Family Habilitation Home

- ❖ No longer available to children who are not yet receiving this service.
- ❖ The Division will keep the service on the waiver to serve current SFHH placements until another residential option is available to the child.
- ❖ Placements will be reviewed by a cross-agency team to determine the appropriate placement for the minor child within the next three (3) years.
- ❖ Participant must be in services for a minimum of 8 hours in a 24-hour period for reimbursement to occur.

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Specialized Equipment

- ❖ Service Definition remains the same.
- ❖ The Division may require an assessment for specialized equipment needs by a Certified Specialized Equipment (CSE) professional. Assessment is funded as a part of the \$2,000 cap.
- ❖ Electronic technology devices are only allowed once every 5 years and like items cannot be purchased during those 5 years.

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Speech, Language, and Hearing Services

- ❖ Service is available as an individual 15 minute unit or as a group session unit.
- ❖ 45 minutes of service per session is required to bill.
- ❖ State plan must be billed for services prior to the waiver paying for them each year.
- ❖ Participant specific training is now required.

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Subsequent Assessment

- ❖ Psychological evaluations for eligibility are no longer required every five years.
- ❖ Psychological evaluations will only be approved due to a significant change in the participant.
- ❖ Any assessments must be prior authorized by the Division.

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Supported Living

- ❖ Assist a participant to live in a home or apartment leased by the participant or guardian, or in the family home when the participant requires a range of community-based support to live as independently as possible.
- ❖ May be billed at a 15-minute unit rate for a maximum of 5,400 units per plan year for services provided to a group up to two or three participants.

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Supported Living

- The plan of care must identify either the daily unit, or the individual or group 15-minute unit, based on the participant's need. Both the daily unit and the 15 minute unit may be on the participant's plan of care, but cannot be used on the same day.
- **CARF accreditation is required** for providers who are certified in any residential service, supported living, community integration, day habilitation , prevocational, and/or supported employment, on plans of care for **three (3) or more participants; and the services amount to \$125,000 per calendar year.**

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Supported Employment

- ❖ Services to support and assist a participant (ages 18+) who needs intensive support to find and maintain a job in a competitive, integrated work setting in the general workforce for which an individual is compensated at or above the minimum wage.
- ❖ Available as Individual (1:1) Service; and
- ❖ Group Supported Employment service.

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Self-Directed Services

- ❖ Independent Support Brokerage
- ❖ Supported Living
- ❖ Self Directed Goods and Services
- ❖ Homemaker
- ❖ Companion Services
- ❖ Personal Care

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Self-Directed Services

- ❖ Supported Employment
- ❖ Child Habilitation Services
- ❖ Respite
- ❖ Residential Habilitation- Shared Living (Comprehensive Waiver only)
- ❖ Individual Habilitation Training.

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DISCONTINUED SERVICES

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Discontinued Services

- Agency with Choice
- Unpaid Caregiver Training

NOTE: Services are not included on the new Supports and Comprehensive Waivers

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Additional Provider Requirements

- ❖ **Positive Behavior Support Training-** A CARF provider serving 5+ participants with restraints or restrictive interventions in their plans are required to have a supervisor successfully complete the Positive Behavior Support curriculum developed by WIND or nationally recognized positive behavior support curriculum approved by the Division. An additional supervisor must be certified for every ten (10) additional participants with restraints or restrictive interventions in their plan.

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Additional Provider Requirements

- ❖ **CARF accreditation** is required for providers who are certified in any residential service, supported living, community integration, day habilitation, prevocational, and/or supported employment, on plans of care for **three or more participants; and the services amount to \$125,000 per calendar year.**

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Additional Provider Requirements

- ❖ **Training requirement for employment services:**

Within one year of being certified in this service 1 staff person working at least 50% of their time as a service supervisor must be certified in a nationally recognized supported employment curriculum and demonstrate that a portion of their time each month is spent training direct care staff.
