Wyoming Department of Health, Medicaid
Nursing Facility Intergovernmental Transfer Program (GAP Payment Program)

Public and Tribal notice is hereby given that effective July 1, 2016, or upon approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, the Wyoming Department of Health, Division of Healthcare Financing (Medicaid) will implement a non-state government owned nursing facility intergovernmental transfer (IGT) program (GAP Payment Program). Pursuant to Enrolled Act No. 46, passed during the 2016 Legislative Session, this program will implement an IGT program for non-state government owned nursing facilities. All IGT monies received from and distributed to qualifying providers will be subject to all federal regulations outlined in the Code of Federal Regulations.

The Department (Medicaid) shall collect and distribute annual payments in an amount up to but not to exceed the applicable upper payment limit gap as calculated from the most recently filed Medicare cost report, and will withhold up to 1% for the payment of administrative expenses incurred by the department or its agents in performing the activities required to administer this program.
