### >> Vaccination Data Quality Report

- > Summarizes vaccinations outside of recommended administration age or administered vaccinations that were given from unspecified vaccine types.
- > Can be used to identify erroneous vaccination practices and to correct and avoid them in the future.

### >> Provider Submission Detail Report

- > Displays the number of patients and vaccinations added or updated during the specified date range and the pre-defined expected reporting methods versus the actual reporting methods for the selected organization/facility.
- > Can be used to give a snapshot view of what your facility is currently doing. Users intending to upload through HL7 can evaluate how often and why they are still entering records manually. Until a bi-directional interface is established with the WyIR that can send AND receive administered vaccines, historical vaccines, and contraindications, there may be a need to continue to enter data in both systems. This report can assist facilities in understanding the reporting burden by their staff.

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## >> Vaccinations Breakdown Report

- > Displays the number of vaccinations administered or recorded as historical for the selected organization and date range on the selected vaccines.
- > Can be used to quickly determine the doses updated by users by vaccine name for the previous month.

## >> Data Quality Report by IRMS and Facility

- > Displays counts and percentages of key data elements that are missing from the specified provider's record set. Also shows the counts and percentages for the patient inactive status and the VFC eligibility on patient and vaccinations.
- > Can be used to ensure that specific fields used by a facility (i.e., phone for Reminder/Recall) are present in the patient's record.

### >> Patient Data Quality Detail

- > Lists the individual patient names and birth dates for patients with missing data elements.
- > Can be used to add and correct protected health Information contained by patient records to ensure completeness of data. The report will display missing values from the Patient's record—be sure to focus upon the ones that have meaning to your facility (i.e., VFC Status) and ignore the ones that do not have meaning (Patient SSN).

### >> Vaccination Data Quality Detail

- > Identifies patient and vaccination records which were outside of the administration age or administered vaccinations that were given from unspecified vaccine types.
- > Can be used to identify issues in the recording of administered vaccinations for further staff education.
