



Adult DUI Arrest Rate Quartiles









Definition: The percentage of Wyoming 10th and 12th grade students that reported having at least one drink of alcohol one or more times in the past 30 days.







Definition: The percentage of Wyoming 10th and 12th grade students reporting having consumed 5 or more drinks in one sitting in the past two weeks.




10th and 12th Grade Binge Drinking Ouartiles





Adult Binge Drinking Quartiles





Social Norms: 30-Day Alcohol Use (Youth)


Definition: The percentage of Wyoming students who thought that most students in their school drank at least once in the past 30 days.




Wyoming Counties 6th and 8th Grade Social Norm Quartiles


Wyoming Counties 10th and 12th Grade Social Norm Quartiles


Definition: The percentage of Wyoming students who believe that most students have binge drank on one or more occasions during the past two weeks.




6th and 8th Grade Social Norm Ouartiles


10th and 12th Grade Social Norm Terciles




