



## INTENT TO USE DRUGS




6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Intent to Use Drugs Terciles





## COMMUNITY DISORGANIZATION




6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Community Disorganization Quartiles

10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Favorable Community Disorganization Quartiles







## FRIENDS' USE OF DRUGS







## PARENTS' ATTITUDE TOWARDS DRUG USE




6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Parents' Attitudes Quartiles







## INTERACTIONS WITH ANTISOCIAL PEERS




6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Interactions with Antisocial Peers Quartiles





## PERCEIVED AVAILABILITY OF DRUGS




6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Perceived Availability of Drugs Quartiles





## SOCIAL SKILLS


**Definition:** The percentage of Wyoming students who are classified as higher protection because their answers to the scale, which measures the student's assertiveness and ability to make responsible social decisions.




### 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Social Skills Quartiles
