

Grades 6 and 8 Intent to Use Drugs Terciles







COMMUNITY DISORGANIZATION




Grades 6 and 8 Community Disorganization Quartiles


Grades 10 and 12 Favorable Community Disorganization Ouartiles

FRIENDS' USE OF DRUGS




Grades 6 and 8 Friends' Use of Drugs Quartiles










Grades 10 and 12 Sensation Seeking Quartiles





INTERACTIONS WITH ANTISOCIAL PEERS




Grades 6 and 8 Interactions with Antisocial Peers Quartiles


Grades 10 and 12 Interactions with Antisocial Peers Quartiles





PERCIEVED AVAILABLITY OF DRUGS


Definition: The percentage of Wyoming 1students who are classified as high risk because their answers to the scale measuring the how easy the students think it is obtain alcohol and other drugs.




Grades 6 and 8 Perceived Availability of Drugs Quartiles


Grades 10 and 12 Perceived Availability of Drugs Quartiles


Definition: The percentage of Wyoming students who are classified as higher protection because their answers to the scale, which measures the student's assertiveness and ability to make responsible social decisions.
