



## Does My Child Qualify?

To be eligible for Kid Care CHIP, children must meet the following guidelines:

- Under 19 years old
- A Wyoming resident
- A US citizen or qualified permanent resident who has lived in the US for 5 years
- Uninsured for 30 days or more (with some exceptions)
- Meet family income guidelines

## Coverage

- Sports and back to school physicals
- Regular check-ups
- Immunizations
- Dentist visits
- Hospital care
- Mental health services
- Prescriptions and more...

## Cost

- No premium
- No deductibles
- \$5 co-pay or \$10 co-pay depending on income level
- No co-pay for verified Native Americans
- All preventive services and immunizations are free of cost

The Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) provides affordable health coverage for eligible Wyoming children and teens.

# Income Requirements



Kid Care CHIP applicants must meet the household income limits to be eligible.

Family Size	Monthly Income Less Than
1	\$2024
2	\$2744
3	\$3464
4	\$4184
5	\$4904
6	\$5624
7	\$6344
8	\$7064
Add for each additional person	\$720 each/month

\*If your household income is close to these limits please apply, you may be eligible. Income requirements change annually. Call 855-294-2127 to apply.
