Wyoming Department of Health, Medicaid  
Recovery Audit Contractor Exemption

April 11, 2017

Wyoming Department of Health, pursuant to the requirements outlined in 42 CFR 447.205, hereby gives notice of the following proposed amendment to the State Plan altering the requirement to maintain a Recovery Audit Contractor (RAC).

**Recovery Audit Contractor (RAC):** Under Section 1902(a)(42)(B)(i) of the Social Security Act, States and Territories are required to establish programs to contract with one or more Medicaid RACs. Wyoming Medicaid is requesting an exception to this requirement. The State of Wyoming currently has a robust Program Integrity Unit, with many of the capabilities of a RAC already built into its functions. The utilization of a RAC is not cost effective for either the State or the Contractors that have previously assisted the State. The State of Wyoming is requesting an exemption to the requirement to maintain an RAC.
