WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO STATE PLAN FOR FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS AND RURAL
HEALTH CENTERS

Public and Tribal notice is hereby given that the Wyoming Department of Health intends to make changes to the Wyoming Medicaid State Plan Amendment for Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC) and Rural Health Centers (RHC).

The Wyoming Department of Health will be updating the State Plan for Federally Qualified Health Centers and Rural Health Centers to change the payment approach to allow facilities to receive reimbursement for Long Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC) in addition to their normal encounter rate reimbursement. The facility may bill for an all-inclusive encounter rate for insertion of the LARC and also bill for the actual LARC itself.
