Rights restrictions documented in the IPC

If rights restrictions are addressed in the Needs and Risks section of an individualized plan of care (IPC), the restriction must also be added to the Rights section of the IPC, and must comply with Chapter 45, Section 4(h) of the Department of Health's Medicaid Rules.

New online case manager training

The Division will be introducing new online trainings for case managers on November 19, which will be available on the [Training](#) page of the Division website. The trainings are entitled *IPC Development and Monitoring* and *Incident Reporting*. These trainings will address the required information that must be documented within the IPC in order for a participant to receive services, and the importance of reporting incidents that involve a participant. Case managers will be able to receive CEU's, and are encouraged to complete these trainings.

Rights Restriction Review Tool

During the December Case Manager Support Call, the Division will be providing an in depth training on the new Rights Restrictions Review Tool and how it will be used to evaluate the rights restrictions included in an IPC. This tool was developed to guide Division staff and case managers in ensuring that rights restrictions meet the requirements established in Chapter 45, Section 4(h) of the Department of Health's Medicaid Rules. As a reminder, rights restrictions should be used as a last resort and should only be imposed if the participant has a specific health or safety need.
