

PUBLIC NOTICE

Wyoming Department of Health

Public notice is hereby given that the Wyoming Department of Health intends to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) to the United States Department of Health and Human Services Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Upon CMS approval, the proposed changes will update the following Sections of the State Plan:

- Supplement 12 to Attachment 2.6-A Addendum - Exempt all wages paid by the Census Bureau for temporary employment related to Census activities for the Medicaid Savings Programs.
- Supplement 3 to Attachment 2.6-A – Define post eligibility treatment of income deductions for institutionalized individuals. Allow a deduction when calculating patient contribution for medical or remedial care expenses, incurred within three months of the Medicaid application, and not subject to payment by Medicaid or other third party insurance. Income deductions for medical or remedial care expenses incurred as the result of imposition of a transfer of resource penalty is limited to zero.
