<b>Regulatory Language: (1910, 1923)</b>		
Infection Control:	YES	NO
Section 5 (xi)		
(A) The home health agency shall develop policies and procedures for employee health including a policy that identifies communicable diseases that could put the client population at risk.		
(B) The home health agency must document that the employee is free of communicable diseases that could be a risk to the client population.		
Section 6. Home Health Aide. (a) Must be a CNA and have completed training to ensure competency in the home setting. This training must be documented and retained in the employee personnel record.		
Section 7 (c) [Training for homemakers] Training shall include:		
(F) Maintaining a clean, safe, and healthy environment		
(G) Universal precautions		
<b><i>Based on observation, record review, and client and staff interview, does the agency have procedures in place for monitoring staff for COVID-19 infection? Are aides and homemakers appropriately trained in COVID-19 prevention? Does the agency respond appropriately to suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19?</i></b>
