

COVID-19: January Vaccine Distribution Information from the Wyoming Department of Health

December 30, 2020

Limited COVID-19 vaccine became available to states on December 12, 2020. The Wyoming Department of Health (WDH) anticipates the following allocation of vaccine across the state for January 2021 based on estimates provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Operation Warp Speed (OWS). Vaccine allocations will be shipped to county public health agencies or in some instances to hospitals to administer to populations identified in Phase 1a and 1b together with their local partners.

Estimated amounts of vaccine to be sent to counties in January are listed in the table. Listed amounts are for 1st dose only. **These amounts are tentative at this time and may change.**

Changes in expected quantities will be communicated and updated in future versions of this document. More details regarding ordering and shipping dates will also be provided to county partners who receive direct vaccine shipments.

Second dose shipments will be sent to each facility that received 1st dose shipments and are not included in the table.

- Pfizer vaccine will be ordered and shipped approximately two weeks after the initial shipment of vaccine.
- Moderna vaccine will be ordered and shipped approximately three weeks after the initial shipment of vaccine.

Additional vaccine is allocated for Wyoming as part of the Federal Pharmacy Partners for Long-Term Care Program. This program ensures Walgreens and CVS pharmacies across the country will provide COVID-19 vaccinations to residents and staff of enrolled long-term care facilities and assisted living facilities within 75 miles of the pharmacy. WDH has worked with county partners to ensure vaccination coverage for facilities that did not enroll or were too far from the pharmacies for the federal program. These vaccinations are tentatively set to begin in early January 2021.
