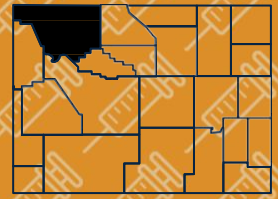

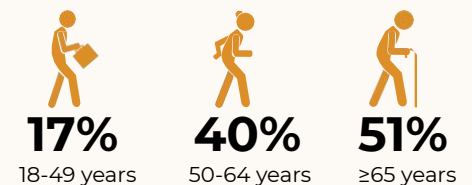
### PARK COUNTY IMMUNIZATION SITES
