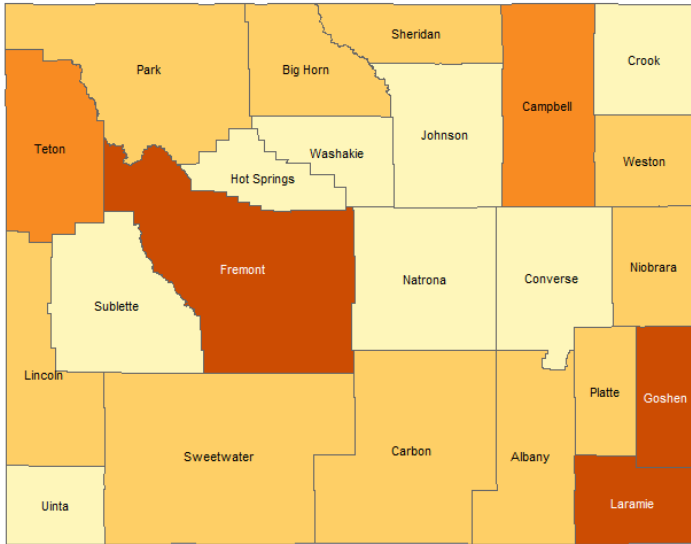


HIV IN WYOMING

2020

HIV, or Human Immunodeficiency Virus, is the virus that can lead to AIDS (Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome) - now called HIV Stage 3. HIV is transmitted through unprotected sex, blood to blood contact, and mother to child through birth and breastfeeding.

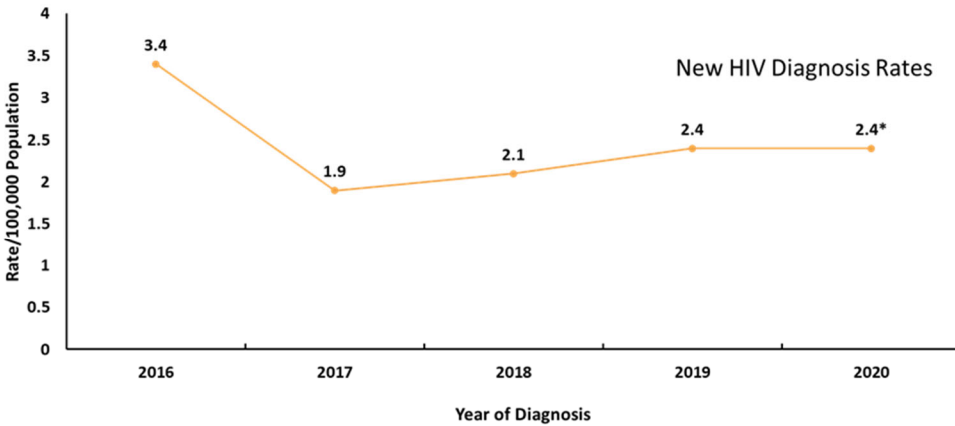

Wyoming HIV Prevalence by County as of December 2020

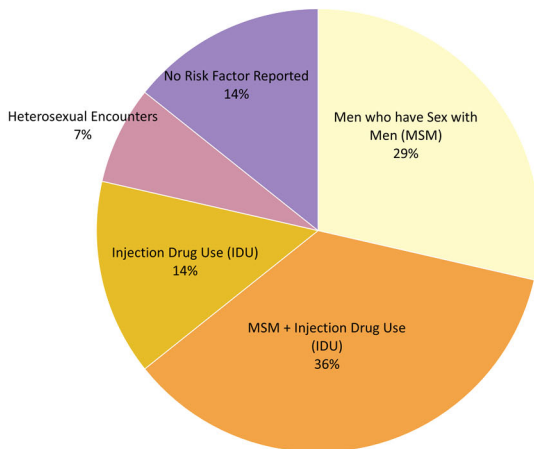
Rate/100,000

***Potential impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on access to HIV testing should be considered when interpreting 2020 rates.**

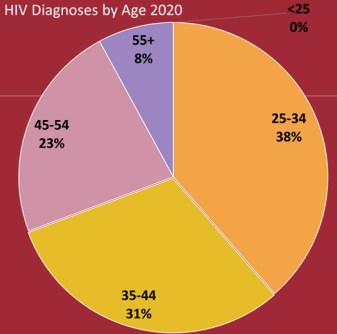
New HIV Diagnoses by Transmission Category 2020



\$125,000

The approximate monthly dollar amount spent by the Communicable Disease Treatment Program to support medication, doctor's visits, laboratory testing, housing, and transportation for individuals infected with HIV.

New HIV Diagnoses by Age 2020



85% of new cases in 2020 were among white males

92% of newly reported infections in 2020 were diagnosed as HIV (not AIDS)

This suggests that nearly all new diagnoses in 2020 were tested early and had opportunities for prevention and treatment interventions.
