## **Our Programs**

#### **Through the Older Americans Act:**

**Title III-B Support Services -** Health services (health education, health exercise, preventative health), socialization services (transportation and assisted transportation, games/recreational activities), supportive services (chore services, counseling, crisis intervention, outreach)

**Title III-C Nutrition -** Home delivered meals, nutrition screening, assessment, education and counseling

Title III-E Caregivers - Counseling, training, information, support, assistance, respite

### **Through State Funding:**

**Wyoming Home Services -** Care coordination, homemaking, personal care, respite, chore, adult daycare, Personal Emergency Response Systems (PERS), home modifications, and medication set up.

#### **Through Emergency State Funding:**

**ERAP-Housing Stability Services -** Providing such services to keep renters in their homes for longer. Services include; Home Modifications, Trailer/Mobile Home Repairs, Homemaking Services, IT Hardware, Independent Living Skills & Hoarding Services.

**VAC5** - Vaccination grant funds are to serve older adults by disseminating credible information about *COVID-19* vaccines, scheduling and transportation.
