



Mission

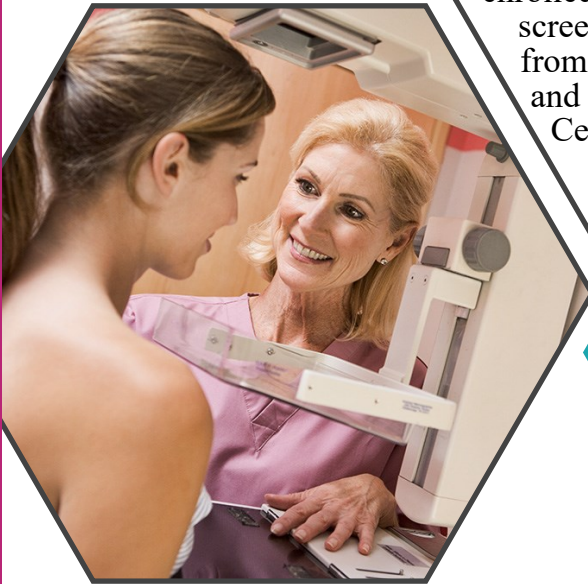
To reduce the burden of cancer through evidence-based screening and prevention strategies, including education, support, collaboration, and resource sharing in Wyoming.

Who We Are

The Wyoming Cancer Program reimburses participating healthcare providers for breast, cervical and colorectal cancer screening services, provided to enrolled clients throughout Wyoming. The screenings are paid for through funds from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention National Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program, the State of Wyoming, and other funders.



Covered Services

Breast Cancer Screening Services

- Mammograms
- Clinical breast exams
- Office visits
- Limited diagnostic services may be covered

Cervical Cancer Screening Services

- Pap test
- HPV testing
- Office visits
- Limited diagnostic services may be covered

Colorectal Cancer Screening Services

- Colonoscopy
- Colonoscopy laboratory fees
- Pre-operative office visit
- Limited diagnostic services may be covered
- Other evidence-based colorectal cancer screenings

Who Is Eligible

Each program has specific eligibility requirements. General eligibility determination is based on:

- Wyoming residency.
- Age, gender, and risk factors.
- Income.
- Having no insurance or being underinsured (having an out of pocket cost you cannot afford).

Final determination will be made upon the submission of a completed application.
