RE: WY.1060.R01.09 and WY.1061.R01.09 amendments

Dear Ms. Green:

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is approving your request to amend the Supports and Comprehensive Waivers for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (ID/DD) ages birth through the life span and individuals with an acquired brain injury age 21 and older. The CMS Control Numbers for these amendments are WY.1060.R01.09 and WY.1061.R01.09. Please use these numbers in future correspondence relevant to these waiver actions.

With these amendments, the state is increasing most of their provider rates, revising their Case Management service to include a Certificate service tier of Case Management and increasing child and adult individual budget amounts in Appendix B to be commiserate with the service rate increases. The effective date of the amendments is February 1, 2022.

The waiver continues to be cost-neutral. The average per capita cost of waiver services estimates (Appendix J.1) have been approved.

The state has identified its intent to use money realized from section 9817 of the American Rescue Plan (ARP). Approval of this action does not constitute approval of the state's spending plan. The state must have an approved spending plan in order to use the money realized from section 9817 of the ARP.
