The National Senior Service Corps is a network of national service programs through volunteer services for Americans 55 years and older, made up of three primary programs that each take a different approach to improving lives and fostering civic engagement. Senior Corps volunteers commit their time to address critical community needs including academic tutoring and mentoring, elderly care, disaster relief support, and more.

The Wyoming Department Health, Community Living Section, in support of the National Senior Corps, provides matching funds for the Foster Grand Parents and Senior Companions Programs of the National Senior Corps services.

Senior Companions are volunteers 55 and over who provide assistance and friendship to seniors who have difficulty with daily living tasks, such as shopping or paying bills. The program aims to help homebound seniors and other adults maintain independence primarily in their own homes, to keep seniors independent longer, and provide assistance to family caregivers.

Foster Grandparents Program is authorized to serve children "having special or exceptional needs or with conditions or circumstances identified as limiting their academic, social, or economic development." Foster Grand Parents are role models, mentors, and friends to children with exceptional needs. This program provides a way for volunteers age 55 and over to stay active by serving children and youth in their communities, where they act as role models to reinforce important life values.
