PUBLIC NOTICE Wyoming Department of Health Clinical Trial Costs

Public notice is hereby given that effective January 1, 2022, the Wyoming Department of Health intends to make changes to the Wyoming Medicaid State Plan regarding routine patient care associated with participation in clinical trials.

The State Plan Amendment (SPA) provides an assurance that the State complies with federal requirements regarding coverage of routine patient care associated with participation in clinical trials added by the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021.

The Consolidated Appropriations Act added a mandatory benefit for routine patient costs for items and services furnished in connection with participation by Medicaid beneficiaries in qualifying clinical trials.

The State estimates there will be no fiscal impact in Federal Fiscal Year 2022 and Federal Fiscal Year 2023 as these services were already covered prior to the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021.
