Wyoming laboratories are responsible for reporting results when a reference laboratory is used.

**Diseases in Black:** Reportable within **24 hours** of diagnosis by fax/telephone/ELR

**Diseases in Green: Reportable within 7 days of diagnosis by fax/phone/mail/ELR**

**LAB:** In addition to reporting, **submit an isolate or other appropriate material**, in accordance with IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations to: State Public Health Laboratory, Combined Laboratories Facility, 208 S College Dr., Cheyenne, WY 82002

**Hepatitis B**, all HBV DNA tests regardless of result (Electronic Lab Reporting Only)

\***Hepatitis C**, including all test results of an infant born to a positive mother\*

**Hepatitis C**, all HCV RNA tests regardless of result (Electronic Lab Reporting Only)

**HIV**, positive/reactive detection tests

**HIV/AIDS**, all CD4s, all viral loads, all genotype results, all previous test results (regardless of result) for newly diagnosed cases, and all perinatal exposures

**Influenza**, hospital electronic lab reporting only
