Amend the Comprehensive and Supports Waivers to Implement High Needs Model Rate Increase

Notice is hereby given to the public that the Wyoming Department of Health, Division of Healthcare Financing (Division) intends to submit an application to amend the Supports and Comprehensive Medicaid Waiver programs to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).

The Supports and Comprehensive Waiver programs provide eligible individuals with a developmental or intellectual disability, or an acquired brain injury, a community-based alternative to the care provided in an institution. The proposed amendments will reflect the increase in specific service reimbursement rates for agency providers, as identified in Senate Enrolled Act 12 adopted during the 2022 Wyoming State Legislative Session (<https://wyoleg.gov/2022/Enroll/SF0001.pdf>). The proposed amendments will also add an individual and agency provider type definition for any affected services. The amendment applications will have a proposed effective date of September 1, 2022.
