

- Screening recommendations



Three KnoWyo testing sites received CDU Funding Opportunity awards to fund condom fit kits at their clinics.


The 2022 Funding Opportunity application will close December 1st at 5pm.

### **Young Adults Asked to Complete Wyoming Health Survey**


