45333	Sigmoidoscopy-with removal of polypoid lesion(s) reimbursement allowed only if colonoscopy is incomplete. Procedure by Physician
45338	Sigmoidoscopy -with removal of tumor(s), polyp(s) or other lesion(s) by snare technique reimbursement allowed only if colonoscopy is incomplete. Procedure by Physician

74270	Radiology-Contrast Barium Enema, with or without KUB reimbursement allowed only if colonoscopy is incomplete. Procedure by Physician
74280	Radiology-Air contrast with specific high density barium, with or without glucagon reimbursement allowed only if colonoscopy is incomplete. <i>Procedure by Physician</i>
