





### **2023 KnoWyo Voucher Guidance & Benchmarks**



The 2023 guidance includes clarifications, and answers to frequently asked questions. As KnoWyo is funded by CDC grants and CDC has resumed state site visits we have now included a Rapid Test Agreement, a KnoWyo Testing Site Agreement, and KnoWyo Voucher Guidance Compliance Log. The KnoWyo Voucher Guidance can be found on the CDU Prevention website under the KnoWyo heading.

The Director/Manager at each KnoWyo testing site must read the guidance, sign the Rapid Test Agreement and the KnoWyo Testing Site Agreement, and email the signed copies to <a href="mailto:cdusupplies@wyo.gov">cdusupplies@wyo.gov</a> by March 31, 2023 at 5pm.

All KnoWyo testing site staff who perform KnoWyo testing or perform administrative tasks associated with KnoWyo vouchers must read the attached guidance, sign the KnoWyo Voucher Guidance Log, and the log must be emailed to <a href="mailto:cdusupplies@wyo.gov">cdusupplies@wyo.gov</a> by March 31, 2023 at 5pm.

KnoWyo testing sites that are not Wyoming Public Health offices, as we have discussed over the last few months, CDU Counseling & Testing training has been developed. This allows CDU to ensure a standard level of knowledge for those performing KnoWyo testing. The material on these links is short. Once all the training is complete take the CDU KnoWyo Counseling and Testing Quiz which is the last link. The training and the test must be completed by March 31, 2023 at 5pm.

## Slightly Revised 340B/EPT Guidance



We had to make some slight revisions to the CDU 340B/EPT Guidance as we are now able to get Cefixime for EPT gonorrhea treatment again and CDC made some treatment recommendation updates since we were last able to get Cefixime. As this change is minor and the clinics who receive CDU 340B and EPT just submitted compliance logs for 2023, clinics will not need to submit new compliance logs for this revision.

### Review of changes

- Updated Table of Contents
- Addition of "medication availability" to the Notice page
- Treatment of Pharyngeal Gonorrhea
  - The partner(s) of clinic patients with pharyngeal gonorrhea MAY NOT receive CDU EPT and must seek testing and treatment in the office.
  - The only recommended treatment for uncomplicated gonococcal infection of the pharynx is 500mg Ceftriaxone.
     No reliable alternative treatments are available for pharyngeal gonorrhea.
- Clarification of EPT eligible use language
- CDU Staff Directory page has been replaced with a link to the CDU Staff Directory page on the CDU website.



### Wyoming U=U Campaign



We are excited to announce the release of our U=U campaign!

U=U stands for "Undetectable equals Untransmittable."

Someone living with HIV who has maintained an undetectable status for at least 6 months cannot pass HIV on to their sexual partners.

When a person living with HIV is actively taking HIV medication and their viral load (the amount of HIV in their blood) stays at undetectable levels, that person cannot transmit HIV to a sexual partner who is HIV-negative. For almost everyone who starts taking their HIV medication, as prescribed, their viral load will drop to an undetectable level in six months or less.
