

Annual CDU 340B Recertifications – Coming Soon



Annual 340B recertification are coming up in April or May. Each subrecipient under CDUs 340B designation must meet the following criteria to be recertified each year for 340B STD and TB Office of Pharmacy Affairs Information System (OPAIS) accounts:

- OPAIS account information must be complete, accurate, and correct.
- The sub-recipient meets all 340B Program eligibility requirements.
- The sub-recipient will comply with all requirements and any accompanying regulations including, but not limited to, the prohibition against duplicate discounts and diversion
- The sub-recipients maintains auditable records (reporting) pertaining to compliance with the requirements.
- The sub-recipient acknowledges its responsibility to contact CDU as soon as possible if there is any change in 340B eligibility and/or breach by the sub-recipient.
