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## DON'T RISK A GAP IN HEALTH COVERAGE.

During the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency the Federal Government allowed recipients of Medicaid and/or Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) benefits to continue with coverage without having to renew their enrollment. In March 2023, the Medicaid and CHIP continuous coverage requirement will no longer be in effect.

Through this unwinding period, you will have to complete a renewal for Medicaid and/or CHIP and through this process may find that you or your family no longer qualify for these programs. However, you may be eligible for a health insurance plan through the Federal health Insurance Marketplace. Enroll Wyoming Navigators are available throughout the State of Wyoming for persons who need help understanding how to navigate the Medicaid or CHIP renewal process, and for those no longer eligible for these programs, how to start a marketplace application and enroll.
