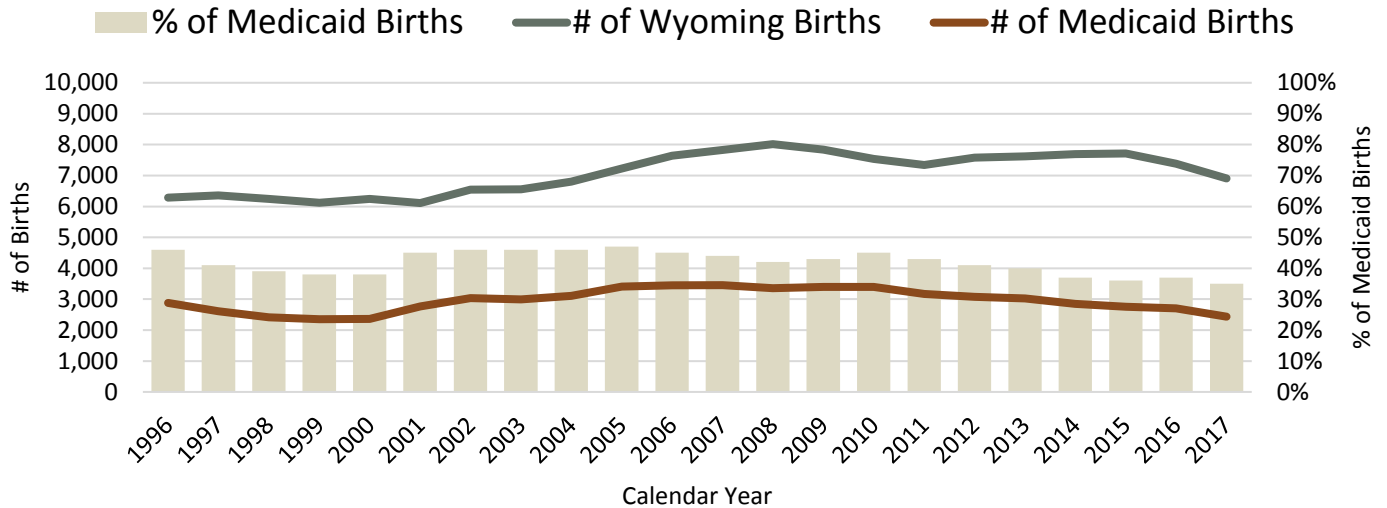


## Wyoming Medicaid Births by Calendar Year

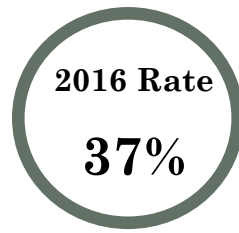

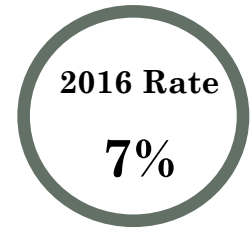
## Wyoming and Medicaid Births by Recipient County

## Summary

This report is based on claims paid through the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) through June 2018 for births occurring in calendar year 2017. The calendar year 2017 data in this report was generated from Cognos report WYDDSS0480. The calendar year 1996 - 2016 data was generated from historical COLD reports O0210A, O0210B, and O0210D. Data for Wyoming statewide births was supplied by Vital Statistics Services.

In summary:

- 6,904 Wyoming resident births occurred in 2017 which is a decrease of 480 from 2016
- 2,439 (35%) Medicaid births occurred in 2017, which is a decrease of 265 births from 2016
- 215 (9%) of the Medicaid births were financed at least partially by third party insurance (TPL) in 2017
- 152 (6%) of the Medicaid births occurred out of state in 2017
- 71 (3%) of the Medicaid births occurred to women who were undocumented non-citizens

This report includes a table to display the number of births by county to non-citizens. These births are covered under the Emergency Services regulation that requires Medicaid to cover labor and delivery charges for undocumented non-citizens.
