PUBLIC NOTICE Wyoming Department of Health Prescription Signature Requirements During the COVID-19 PHE

Public notice is hereby given that the Wyoming Department of Health intends to submit a Disaster Relief State Plan Amendment (SPA) to the United States Department of Health and Human Services Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Upon CMS approval, the proposed changes will be effective March 1, 2020 and will expire at the end of the federally declared COVID-19 Public Health Emergency.

Wyoming Medicaid is creating this State Plan Amendment to waive the requirement for patient or patient representative signature at the pharmacy during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency when receiving a medication covered by Wyoming Medicaid.

There is no estimated federal fiscal impact associated with this amendment.
