Wyoming Department of Health  
Streamlined Application Changes

Public notice is hereby given that the Wyoming Department of Health intends to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) to the United State Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

The amendment to the State Plan is to make the following changes to the Third Party Liability (TPL) Wyoming Attachments 4.22A and 4.22B of the State Plan for Medicaid and Kid Care CHIP:

- SSA State Wage Information Collection Agency and Title IV-A data match not currently utilized; however, data matching will begin with the Department of Workforce Services on July 01, 2023 to confirm income information and possible creation of a commercial insurance lead for verification by the TPL vendor.
- Data matching with commercial health insurance (disclosure of health care eligibility) and disclosure of health insurance coverage at the time of Medicaid application and annual renewal of benefits
- Changes to the use of trauma diagnosis codes for identification of and collection from liable third parties.
- Incorporation of changes required by the Balance Budget Act of 2018 for cost avoidance of prenatal services, for preventative pediatric care for continued pay and chase of these services, and for claims related to child support enforcement beneficiaries and continued pay and chase of these claims.
- Addition of threshold dollar amounts for post payment recovery from health insurance carriers.
