| 74261    | CT Colonography-Diagnostic including image post processing without contrast material reimbursement allowed only if colonoscopy is incomplete. <i>Procedure by Physician</i>           |
| 74262    | CT Colonography-Diagnostic with contrast material reimbursement allowed only if colonoscopy is incomplete. Procedure by Physician   |
| 74270    | Radiology-Contrast Barium Enema, with or without KUB reimbursement allowed only if colonoscopy is incomplete. Procedure by Physician  |
| 74280    | Radiology-Air contrast with specific high density barium, with or without glucagon reimbursement allowed only if colonoscopy is incomplete. <i>Procedure by Physician</i>             |
