

**Quick Fact:** <u>Bacille Calmette-Guérin (BCG)</u> is a vaccine for tuberculosis (TB) disease. This vaccine is not widely used in the United States. However, it is often given to infants and small children in other countries where TB is common. BCG does not always protect people from getting TB.
