

PARTICIPANT- DIRECTED SERVICES

Participant- Directed Services (PDS) is a service delivery model that allows Participants on the Community Choices Waiver (CCW) to receive support in their homes and communities, the way they want it.

This means relative providers (excluding spouses) can be paid to provide personal support services.

CCW has an ammendment in the works for spouses. Check back soon!

Participant Directed Services

Participant

- Recruit, hire & manage employees to perform the services within his or her plan of care.
- You can direct your own services, or you can select someone you trust to direct services on your behalf.

- Recruit, hire & Manage employees to preform the services within the participant's plan of care.
