

Plan of Safe Care (POSC) Implementation Checklist

- Identify a patient care team
 - Who will the members be?
 - What will each member's role be?
- Decide on how universal verbal or written screening will occur
 - Will it be part of the Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) model so that Medicaid can be billed?
 - Are your current screening questions evidence based? If not, we highly recommend the 5 P's
 - Would this need to be built into your Electronic Medical Record (EMR) flow?
 - Does staff need training on how to screen?
- What will be the process if a family is identified?
 - Who will provide the parent with information and develop the POSC with them?
- Does this family warrant a report to the Department of Family Services (DFS) for safety concerns?
 - Decide as a team on what situations require a report to DFS. Remind everyone that a positive toxicology doesn't automatically require a report... must have safety concerns.
- Who and how will the DFS de-identified notification occur?
 - Outline a process for both scenarios
 - Who will put in the de-identified notification and how often?
- Provide mandatory referral to Child Development Center (CDC)
- Provide families with any other necessary referrals
 - Home visiting may be a great opportunity to have the family supported postpartum
 - Hospitals don't have to ensure families follow through with the referral but they do need to ensure the plan resides with a gatekeeper
 - Who is your gatekeeper? Is it the CDC, a state facilitator, the OB provider, pediatrician, treatment provider or center?
- Begin scheduling training for staff and providers
 - Overall substance use training
 - Overcoming Stigma
 - Screening
 - Identifying infants affected by substance use
 - Consider "Eat, Sleep, Console" as an evidence based intervention in place of Finnagen
- Begin regular meetings with patient care team to figure out the flow and processes
- Identify one person from the hospital team that will participate in the Community Collaborative when implemented.
 - 8-12 static people to meet 1x monthly to provide wrap-around care to family
 - Hospital team member will ensure the process from the birth event into the community is smooth and vice versa.
