#### **Black History Month**

The origins of Black History Month date back to the early 20th century. It was established to address the lack of recognition and inclusion of Black history in American education and culture. Dr. Carter G. Woodson, often referred to as the "Father of Black History," played a pivotal role in its creation. In 1926, he initiated "Negro History Week," which later evolved into Black History Month.

Black History Month was officially recognized by the U.S. government in the 1970s, and since then, it has grown into a nationwide celebration of African American heritage and achievements. Read More



#### **National Condom Month**

National Condom Week is the same week as Valentine's Day in the USA. The observance raises awareness about the condom's use and its importance to safe sex.

In fact, the entire month of February is National Condom Month. Originally started on the campus of the University of California – Berkeley, it has grown into an educational event for high schools, colleges, AIDS groups, sexually transmitted disease awareness groups, pharmacies, and condom manufacturers.
