Every year, March is designated Women's History Month by presidential proclamation. The month is set aside to honor women's contributions in American history.



World TB Day is a day to educate the public about the impact of TB around the world. Read more



May 23rd - Sexual Health Is Mental Health Virtual Conference



Celebrating 5 years as a 501c3 non-profit organization, Something Positive for Positive People (SPFPP) will be presenting an analysis of its most recent herpes stigma survey at its very first online conference. The theme of this conference is "Sexual Health is Mental Health", focusing on herpes stigma in healthcare, how one's identity can be interconnected with their sexuality after an STI diagnosis, and the physical expressions of stigma that can sometimes lead to suicide ideation. We will also present SPFPP's proposed solutions to the symptoms of herpes stigma which will have a secondary impact on STD Prevention efforts & Sex Education programs.

This conference is for Public Health professionals, especially who might work with individuals living with herpes, as well as mental health professionals. Anyone can come learn how to be a better ally and support people navigating herpes stigma.

Changes in Sexual Behaviors Opposite-Sex Partners and STI Outcomes in the United States



March 12, 2024 – 11 AM MT (Webinar)

Over the last decade, rates of STI diagnosis have been climbing, revealing disparities across age groups and racial/ethnic backgrounds. Although trends in sexual behaviors with opposite-sex partners have shown stability since 2000, there's more to uncover. Our aim was to unravel the national temporal trends in sexual behaviors with opposite-sex partners, dissect sexual network attributes, and examine self-reported STI outcomes from 2008-2019; to grasp how changes in STI testing, condom use, and coital frequency influence STI diagnosis rates. Join NCSD and Coalition for Applied Modeling for Prevention (CAMP) for a webinar event where we'll navigate through these trends and deepen your understanding of their implications. We'll hear from Drs. David Katz and Deven Hamilton at the University of Washington, and Dr. Matthew Hogben of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention — you'll be able to participate in an open discussion with these panelists, so have your questions ready!
