"Rules and Regulations for Wyoming Emergency Medical Services Act of 1977", W.S. 33-36-101, Chapter 4 RESPONSE AND REPORTING REQUIRMENTS, Section 4 Patient Care Reporting.

- (a) To promote the uniform provision and accountability of the comprehensive emergency medical services and trauma system, all EMS agencies and their personnel shall utilize the Division's electronic patient care reporting system to document the provision of emergency medical services or related trauma care.
- (d) EMS personnel that provide care to a patient shall submit complete and accurate patient care reports for every request for service in the electronic system maintained by the division no later than two (2) hours after the ambulance or agency is returned to service and available for response...

About the Validation Score:

An agency's Validation Score is a numerical score used to indicate the level of validation rule completeness of a patient care report in the Wyoming Ambulance Trip Reporting System (WATRS). This score is generated based on issues identified as:

- a) Related to an Injury/Illness.
- b) Relevant to the encounter.
- c) Public Health Monitoring.
- d) Estimation of Importance.
- e) National and State Schematron Rules.

The WATRS software enables validation rules to be customized to check the input of data based on conditions. This "configuration" of the validation rules provides the ability to score or weight the value of particular data element being collected. The points set for any specific rule can range from zero (no point deduction however flagged) to 100. When the conditions of a rule are met, the points are applied to the validity score of the incident report.

The OEMS WATRS Administrator receives input from EMS agencies, the WATRS Advisory Group, epidemiology, the Trauma Program and other(s) regarding the priority of data elements and assigns a number of points to be deducted if those fields are left blank or entered improperly.

The lower the validation score, the less complete the identified fields on the patient care report is. A validation score of 100 indicates that all identified fields are completed. This is only a measure of *values entered in identified data fields* and not *accuracy*. For example, a validation score cannot ensure that the correct address is entered or that the patient's name is spelled correctly, just that an address or name was entered.

State wide validation rules are applied evenly throughout Wyoming, however an agency may add a custom validation rule specific to their needs too. If a specific event indicates the validation rule may not apply, consideration is given to determine if the WATRS can accommodate the exception.

Available from the Wyoming Office of EMS:

- Access to the WATRS Elite software package for patient care reporting.
- Reporting templates for transporting agencies, critical care and non-transporting agencies.
- Agency template customization.
- Initial and recurring training in the use of the WATRS Elite system.
- Ability to upload electrical cardiograph (ECG) rhythm strips or 12-lead ECGs from various vendors.
- Robust agency reporting with prebuilt reports, custom reports, and national EMS measures.
- Health Information Exchange with integration to receiving hospital medical records systems.
