

Quick Reference Guide: Official Vaccination Record-School Form


This quick reference guide outlines the process to obtain an official state record of immunization for a patient using the Wyoming Immunization Registry (WyIR).

An official record of immunization might be used for:

- School entry
- Childcare entry
- Travel
- Personal record keeping

Instructions to obtain an official state record of immunization for a specific patient:

1. Log on to the WyIR.
2. Click “Search/Add” under the “Patient” menu heading.
 - a. Please see [Quick Reference Guide: Search for Patient](#)
3. Select the patient that meets your search criteria, making sure to verify you have the correct patient.
4. Click on “Report Module” under the “Reports” Menu heading.
5. The “State Reports” window will open.
6. Click on “School form.”
7. The patient’s official state record of immunization will open. The record must be printed and signed by a Physician/Designee or public health authority.
