



The Wyoming Department of Health, Communicable Disease Unit (CDU) manages HIV, chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, hepatitis B virus, hepatitis C virus, and tuberculosis prevention, surveillance, linkage to care, and technical assistance for Wyoming. Below is a brief summary of services available from CDU.

Care and Prevention Planning Alliance (CAPPA)

- Statewide community planning group for HIV, chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, and hepatitis B and C. Our CAPPA meetings bring together a diverse group of professionals, stakeholders, and population members with lived experience to provide insight on how to best meet the needs of Wyoming's population.

Communicable Disease Prevention Program

- CDU Testing Recommendations
 - The WDH CDU Testing Recommendations begin with national CDC Recommendations and are then adjusted according to risk factors reported to CDU staff during interviews with positive cases in Wyoming. The resulting [CDU Testing Recommendations document](#) is specific to how the infections transmit and present in the Wyoming population.
- KnoWyo Shop
 - Prevention supplies are available at no cost for eligible locations.
 - Locations must be pre-approved before orders are fulfilled; allow three weeks for delivery on all KnoWyo Shop items. Some items, such as rapid tests and testing supplies, have eligibility criteria. The item(s) will not be fulfilled if the eligibility criteria are unmet. - CDU Monthly Newsletters
 - Program updates, training opportunities, and CDU Hero recognition.
- CDU Monthly Webinars
 - Topics are related to HIV, sexually transmitted infections (STIs), hepatitis, and TB prevention, testing, treatment, and linkage to care. Details are included in each CDU Monthly Newsletter.
- Tuberculosis (TB)
 - Financial assistance for TB-related costs, such as IGRAs, chest x-rays, liver function tests, and sputum cultures.
 - Medication assistance for TB treatment may be available for those who qualify. The prior authorization request form for this service can be found on the [CDU TB website](#).
 - Technical assistance related to TB risk, prevention, testing, treatment, and linkage to care.
 - Annual TB Cohort and Advisory Meeting for clinicians providing TB care and services.

- HIV Peer Support Navigators are individuals living with HIV or parents/guardians of children living with HIV who have special training and a willingness to provide HIV navigation support to others living with HIV. - Expedited Partner Therapy (EPT) STI medications for eligible locations. Details regarding CDU EPT can be found at the bottom of the [CDU Prevention website](#).
- KnoWyo Vouchers Safety-Net Testing
 - Available to safety-net healthcare providers, including Wyoming public health offices, Title X Clinics, FQHCs, student health clinics, eligible non-profit clinics, and county correctional facilities. Testing sites are listed on the [KnoWyo.org](#) “Find a Clinic” tab.
 - CDU provides free rapid HIV and hepatitis C virus (HCV) tests for CLIA Waived Wyoming safety-net¹ testing sites in compliance with the current [KnoWyo Voucher Guidance](#).
 - CDU pays eligible KnoWyo Voucher testing sites \$15 per CDU rapid HIV test to perform the test and enter the demographics, risk, and results into the CDU data surveillance system.
 - CDU will reimburse eligible clinics for the cost (at Wyoming Public Health Lab rates) of approved HIV, STI, and hepatitis B & C tests for eligible patients. KnoWyo Voucher reimbursement decreases the cost of HIV, STI, and hepatitis testing to patients and allows clinics to utilize funding in other areas of patient care.
 - CDU promotes and advertises KnoWyo, linking patients to testing and additional clinic services at KnoWyo Voucher testing sites.

Communicable Disease HIV Treatment Program (CDTP)

- Medical and non-medical case management services for people living with HIV in Wyoming.
- Cost assistance for HIV-related medical services, medication, mental health care, substance use treatment, housing services, and other supportive services for eligible people in Wyoming living with HIV. Communicable Disease Surveillance Program

- Epidemiologists/Disease Intervention Specialists (DIS)
 - Interview, education, and partner services for gonorrhea, syphilis, HIV, hepatitis B, and hepatitis C cases.
