

# Wyoming MOMs+ Program Opportunity



## Mission

Our goal is for all Wyoming birthing hospitals to have the tools to provide access to treatment and recovery for perinatal patients with substance use disorders.

The Wyoming Perinatal Quality Collaborative has partnered with MOMs+ to assess the current landscape for treatment and recovery of perinatal substance use disorders (SUDs) in Wyoming, and focus on helping birthing hospitals statewide provide access to treatment and recovery for this vulnerable population. MOMs+ supports several state Perinatal Quality Collaborative's nationwide.

## Pillars of Care:

1. Connection to the patient, baby, and family.
2. Initiation of treatment with medication for opioid use disorder and other substance use disorders.
3. Transition to outpatient treatment and/or recovery with community providers.

## Pilot:

MOMs+, in partnership with the Wyoming Perinatal Quality Collaborative, will work with **three to five birthing hospital pilot sites** across the state to assess needs. We will perform a hospital survey and community surveillance to determine the strengths and opportunities within each site. We will provide a needs assessment and gap analysis back to hospitals with suggestions for an implementation plan based on best-practice recommendation. We will facilitate partnership with community providers, practices, and organizations that will enhance long term recovery of perinatal patients. We will provide troubleshooting and implementation guidance to hospitals that are launching new services and programs.

## Timeline

**April 1st at 3 pm & April 3rd at 12 pm**- information sessions will be held virtually

**April 18th**- due date for sites to express interest in joining the pilot

**April 19th-30th**- meet with key stakeholders at interested sites and finalize enrollment of **3-5 pilot sites**

**May 1st-31st**- pilot sites will complete readiness assessment survey and staff survey

**June 30th**- pilot sites will receive a gap analysis from the MOMs+ team

**July - August**- the MOMs+ team will visit the pilot sites to conduct site visits  
- After the site visit, pilot sites will receive their implementation plans

**September 30th**- round 1 pilot implementation work begins

**October 1st and beyond**- expansion of the MOMs+ program to other birthing hospitals in Wyoming

**Round 1 pilot sites will be provided up to a \$10,000 stipend to help support their participation in the program.**
