*Participation in the Adult Hepatitis Vaccine Program is limited to Public Health Nursing Offices and Correctional Facilities only

Adult Vaccine Initiative

Eligibility Criteria:

19 years and older, and

- Wyoming Resident, and
- Underinsured or Uninsured
- No history of previously completed vaccination series

Administration Fee: Not to exceed \$21.72 per shot/dose/spray
